Admission Requirements Mason undergraduate students majoring in Civil and Infrastructure Engineering, BS may apply to this option if they have earned 90 undergraduate credits with an overall GPA of at least 3.30 and completed all MATH and PHYS requirements. Criteria for admission are identical to criteria for admission to the Systems Engineering, MS program. Accelerated Options Requirement Students must complete all credits that satisfy requirements for both the BS and MS programs. Up to two courses (6 credits) of approved master's level courses taken as part of the undergraduate degree may be applied to the graduate degree. The courses selected for this purpose must be approved by the academic advisors of both the BS and MS programs and by the SEOR department chair. For the BS programs that allow undergraduate electives from the department of systems engineering and operations research, the students may chose the graduate version of such elective courses to replace the corresponding undergraduate courses.
